 - We have numerous clinical opportunities (physicians, dentists, nurses, hygienists, dental assistants, physical therapists, etc.)
 - We also have opportunities for those without clinical experience: most of our office team is composed of volunteers who answer phones, greet patients, schedule appointments, make reminder calls, and provide a loving, welcoming environment
 - We also hope in the future to develop a team of folks who will be trained and available to minister to patients simply by listening to them and praying for them-both for physical and spiritual needs
